**NOTICE OF RACE**

## 1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 USCG approved PFD's shall be worn at all times by all CFJ, Laser, Byte, Vanguard 15 and Sabot competitors while on the water, other than for brief periods while adding or removing clothing. The 'Y' flag will not be flown. This modifies RRS 40 and the preamble to Part 4.

## 2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all J105, Star, CFJ, Laser, Laser Radial, Byte, Vanguard 15, Sabot A, B, C1, C2 and C3 boats.
- 2.2 Skippers must be members in good standing with their respective yacht clubs and class associations to be eligible to sail in this event.
- 2.3 Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form and sending it, together with the required fee to Newport Harbor Yacht Club before Wednesday September 14, 2005 to avoid late fee penalties. All entries must be received by the close of registration on Saturday 9/17/05.

- 2.4 A representative from each boat must check-in with the Regatta Office at Newport Harbor Yacht Club on Saturday, September 17, 2005 between 0830-1030 hrs.

## 4. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available upon Check In at the Newport Harbor Yacht Club.

## 5. RACING AREA

- 5.1 Vanguard 15, Sabot A, B, C1, and C2 boats will be racing in the harbor north of the Main Dock of the Newport Harbor Yacht Club.
- 5.2 Sabot C3 boats will be racing in the Lido Channel.
- 5.3 The CFJ, Laser and Byte classes will race in Race Area 1 in the Pacific Ocean. The Sailing Instructions will provide a more exact location.
- 5.4 The J105 and Star classes will race in Race Area 2 in the Pacific Ocean. The Sailing Instructions will provide a more exact location

**6. THE COURSES**

The courses for all classes will be windward -leeward type courses or any variation of a triangular or other course. A leeward gate may be used at the Race Committee's discretion.

**7. SCORING**

7.1 Six (6) races are scheduled of which two (2) shall be completed to constitute a series.

7.2 When fewer than five (5) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

7.3 When six (6) or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

**8. RADIO COMMUNICATION**

A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

**9. TROPHIES**

9.1 Trophies will be awarded Sunday, September 18, 2005 as soon as possible after the last race.

9.2 The Winner of the J105 Fleet will be awarded the Don Bever Memorial Trophy.

9.3 The winner of the CFJ class will be awarded the SCYYRA Commodore's Cup Perpetual Trophy.

**10. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to during, or after the regatta.

# EVENT INFORMATION

## **PARKING**

The NHYC parking lot is for members only. Regatta participant parking passes will be issued at registration to visiting competitors. Cars without member stickers, or regatta permits are subject to towing. Street parking is available. Please be aware that trailers parked on the street must be attached to a car. Parking in the alley is not allowed and the Newport Beach police department will issue tickets.

## **MOORING AND DOCKAGE**

Boat owners will be offered free mooring, rafting or dry storage at the Newport Harbor Yacht Club from September 15-20, 2005. Boat owners must make advance reservations by contacting the NHYC Dockmaster at 949-673-7730. For extended stays a fee of \$ 0.40 per foot per day will apply.

NHYC has two hoists, which competitors will be allowed to use. Boat owners will need to provide their own slings.
